1	Passport (LS)	Must have a validity of at least 6 months prior to the returning date and 3 blank pages.			
2	Italian National D visa application Form				
3	Color ID Photos (x2)	Can be done at VFS Global for an extra fee (check list)

5	Photocopy of all previous visas				
6	Proof of Transport (LS)	<b>Confirmed</b> air ticket, or other mode of transport, proving the arrival into Italy.			
7	Travel Insurance (LS)	Must be: - valid for the entire Schengen area - valid for the duration of the stay; - cover for a minimum of 30.000 Euros; For long stays a minimum 30 days policy is necessary awaiting for the registration of the residence permit.			
8	Proof of Funds	In the form of a proof of the availability of in excess of 30.000 Euros per year from revenues generated by investments and not by an employment.			
9	Proof of accommodation in Italy	Rental contract for a minimum period of 1 year or proof of ownership of property in Italy			
10	Proof of Residence in SA	In the form of a utility bill or bank statement.			
11	Proof of Payment	Copy of the VFS's receipt.
